- Clothes for 9 days (clothes can be reworn, if desired)

Fundraising Ideas:

1) SOCIAL MEDIA

-Post that you are going on a mission trip to an unreached part of the world and that people can partner with you financially or through prayer. Don't be ashamed in asking for help. People wanna give towards the gospel!

2) FUNDRAISING LETTERS/EMAILS

-Send letters with details about your trip and ask people to partner with you through prayer and giving. In letters, you can share where you are going and what you are doing. For mailed letters, include self-addressed, stamped envelopes for people to return their gifts. For tax deductible donations, ask donors to make the check to LifeGate Church, and include your name and MISSIONS on the memo line.

3) SELL SOMETHING

-Whether it's tshirts, baked goods, or craftsman items, people love to buy products for a good cause. Sell online or in person and let people know it's a product for a good cause.

4) PROVIDE SERVICES

-Babysitting, lawn care, house cleaning...whatever you're good at!
